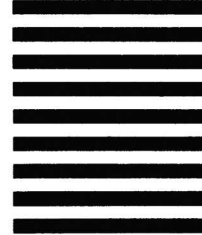

**VOTING INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Ballots are provided for **primary members** only. Joint owners may not vote.
2. To vote, you must be 16 years or older by the end of 2020 and have been a member of Education First Credit Union on January 1, 2021.
3. You may vote for 3 candidates or less. However, voting for more than 3 will invalidate the ballot. **Vote for not more than 3 candidates.**
4. Your **signature** and your **account number** are required to validate the ballot.
5. To mail: fold and tape (no postage required). **Do not staple.** DO NOT ENCLOSE ANY OTHER CREDIT UNION BUSINESS WITH THE BALLOT.
6. Official Ballots must be mailed directly to the address on the reverse of the ballot and received by February 28, 2021, to be considered a valid ballot. Ballots will be accepted at Credit Union offices. Ballots will not be accepted in night depositories.
7. Election results will be announced at the Annual Meeting on Tuesday, March 16, 2021, at Education First Credit Union / 510 E. Mound St., Cols., OH 43215 – at 5:30 pm.
