



The IRS is beginning to distribute a second round of Economic Impact Payments, also referred to as stimulus payments or stimulus checks.

Your eligibility, the amount you will receive, and where and when your payment will be made is the sole decision of the IRS. Our branches and Member Service Center unfortunately do not have access to this information.
